Vista Valley Local Rules

INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE – When located in hazards, all obstructions are deemed an integral part of the course. These integral parts of the course include all bridges, rock walls, cables, rods, wires or wrappings when closely attached to trees, plastic liners in bunkers, concrete/asphalt liners and wood pilings, unless otherwise provided for in the Local Rules A ddendum for a specific tournament.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS – When not located in hazards, include all rock walls, yardage medallions in fairways, concrete/asphalt paths and plastic stone coverings. Relief provided only for stance and/or area of intended swing under Rule 24-2(b)(i).

EMBEDDED BALL THROUGH THE GREEN – Local Rule as prescribed in Appendix I will be in effect. Relief as prescribed in Rule 25-2.

Through the green, a ball that is embedded may be lifted, cleaned and dropped, without penalty, as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green. Note: A ball is "embedded" when it is in its own pitch-mark and part of the ball is below the level of the ground. A ball does not necessarily have to touch the soil to be embedded (e.g., grass, loose impediments and the like may intervene between the ball and the soil). Exceptions: 1. A player may not take relief under this Local Rule if the ball is embedded in sand in an area that is not closely-mown. 2. A player may not take relief under this Local Rule if interference by anything other than the condition covered by this Local Rule makes the stroke clearly impracticable.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS NEAR PUTTING GREEN – Offers a relief option where a player MAY take relief from immovable obstructions near the putting green, without penalty. "If the players ball lies through the green and an immovable obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows: The ball must be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay that (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids interference and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green. "If the player's ball lies on the putting green and an immovable obstruction within two club-lengths of the putting green intervenes on the line of putt, the player may take relief as follows: The ball must be lifted and placed at the nearest point to where the ball lay that (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids interference and (c) is not in a hazard." (See rule 24-2b for relief procedures)

ACCIDENTAL MOVEMENT OF A BALL ON A PUTTING GREEN – Rules 18-2, 18-3 and 20-1 are modified as follows: When a player's ball lies on the putting green, there is no penalty if the ball or ball-marker is accidentally moved by the player, his partner, his opponent, or any of their caddies or equipment. The moved ball or ball-marker must be replaced as provided in Rules 18-2, 18-3 and 20-1. This Local Rule applies only when the player's ball or ball-marker lies on the putting green and any movement is accidental.

Note: If it is determined that a player's ball on the putting green was moved as a result of wind, water or some other natural cause such as the effects of gravity, the ball must be played as it lies from its new location. A ball-marker moved in such circumstances is replaced."
